(A) Different Topics in Voice and Voice Disorders in the

Different Stages of Life, including but not limited to the latest approaches in diagnosing and treating voice disorders, including:

- Mini-micro suture technique in phono surgery: Tips and tricks
- Muscle-specific voice therapy: A vector analysis approach
- Singing voice therapy: Principles and techniques
- Innovative voice therapy techniques,
- Technology-assisted vocal rehabilitation,
- Office-based laryngeal procedures: indications and requirements.
- Surgical approaches for organic voice problems.
- Paediatric airway and voice problems.
- Critical care and laryngeal complications of intubation and tracheostomy.

(B) Dysphagia in the Different Stages of Life: Including but not

limited to the latest techniques and tools for assessing and diagnosing swallowing disorders in children and adults, including:
